

NAPERVILLE ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP

TWO YEARS AT BENEDICTINE UNIVERSITY OR NORTH CENTRAL COLLEGE

SPONSOR: Rotary Club of Naperville, Naperville Rotary Charities and Benedictine University or North Central College

PURPOSE: To assist a financially needy degree seeking student transferring from College of DuPage for two years study at Benedictine University or North Central College leading to a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor in Business Administration or Bachelor of Science degree.

CRITERION FOR SELECTION: Financial need, academic performance, and service to school and community.

Eligibility to Apply for Award:

- Student must be a United States citizen
- Student cannot be a child or grandchild of a Rotarian
- Student must possess a cumulative college GPA of 3.00 (4.0 scale)
- Student must file a FAFSA (Available 1/1/08). Benedictine University or North Central College must receive results of the FAFSA electronically by deadline. Please use the following FAFSA Codes: BU: 001767, NCC 001734

Eligibility to maintain scholarship:

- Student must be a full-time student (at least 12 credit hours per term at Benedictine University or 8 credit hours per term at North Central College) and student must maintain full-time enrollment in consecutive terms (summer term not applicable).
- Student must maintain a 2.75 GPA while at Benedictine University or North Central College.
- Student must attend one Rotary Club of Naperville meeting per year.
- Student must adhere to Benedictine University "Statement of Responsibilities" or North Central College "Statement of Student Conduct and College Policy".
